Preparation for Weaving: Review Class

Includes:

- Reading complicated drafts (color order, brackets, crammed, spaced, keeping track)
- Revised project plans (drafts for threading today)
- Winding a warp and dressing a loom front to back (dressed looms to be used in a later class called Terrific Twill Towels and dressing a loom earns you credit toward the fee for that class)
- Correcting threading errors
- Answering your questions

Class meets in my home studio 388 Mayapple Lane, Boone, IA from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Bring a sack lunch.

Fee \$50 includes instruction, equipment use and packet of project records. Class size: 3 - 8.

Class Date: Friday, May 5 *or* Saturday, May 6 *or* Monday, May 8. Let me know the day that works best for you by April 15 and I will schedule the class to suit most participants. I will let you know which day the class will meet.

Terrific Twill Towels or Runners

Looms are threaded in 8/2 cotton and waiting for you to weave. You will use my 8/2 cotton as the weft. Looms dressed in:

Twill gamps - 4-H and 8-H

Star Motif (color & weave) 4-H and 8-H

Turned twill blocks - 8-H

Ozark Quilter - (point & broken twill) 4-H

Spring Bouquet - (straight & broken twill) 4-H

Mission - (turned Taquete threaded twill) 4-H

Place: my home studio, 388 Mayapple Lane, Boone, IA

Time: 9:00 am - 5:00 pm

Lunch: potluck - bring something to share. I will have plates and coffee or tea.

Dates studio will be open for weaving: Fri. May 26, Sat. May 27, and Mon. May 29

Fees: * Equipment use and instruction/help and project record sheets \$55

(Review Class participants fee is \$30)

* Thread used in your woven project which will be weighed: \$1/ounce (ex. 4 oz. woven piece = \$4)

Please indicate days you plan to come and which project/projects you would most like to weave.
